TANK’s Bike & Ride program celebrates it’s 1 year anniversary in June!



Get moving this summer with TANK’s Bike & Ride program. All buses are equipped with bike racks for easy on-easy off use. TANK’s Bike and Ride program is a great way to get around. Just load your bike on the rack provided and you’re ready to roll. Keep in mind the quick tips below as you ride this summer.

- Passengers are responsible for loading/unloading bicycles in a timely manner.
- Bikes are mounted to the bus at passengers own risk. TANK assumes no liability for stolen property.
- Bicycle racks can carry two bicycles at a time and are available on a first come, first serve basis. If the rack is full, the passenger will need to wait for the next bus. Bicycles are not allowed inside of the bus.
- Bicycles may not be locked to the rack.
- Tricycles, mopeds, tandems and recumbents are not permitted. These items do not fit safely into the racks.
- All willing and able passengers are permitted to use the racks. Children age twelve (12) and younger may use the rack when accompanied by an adult.
